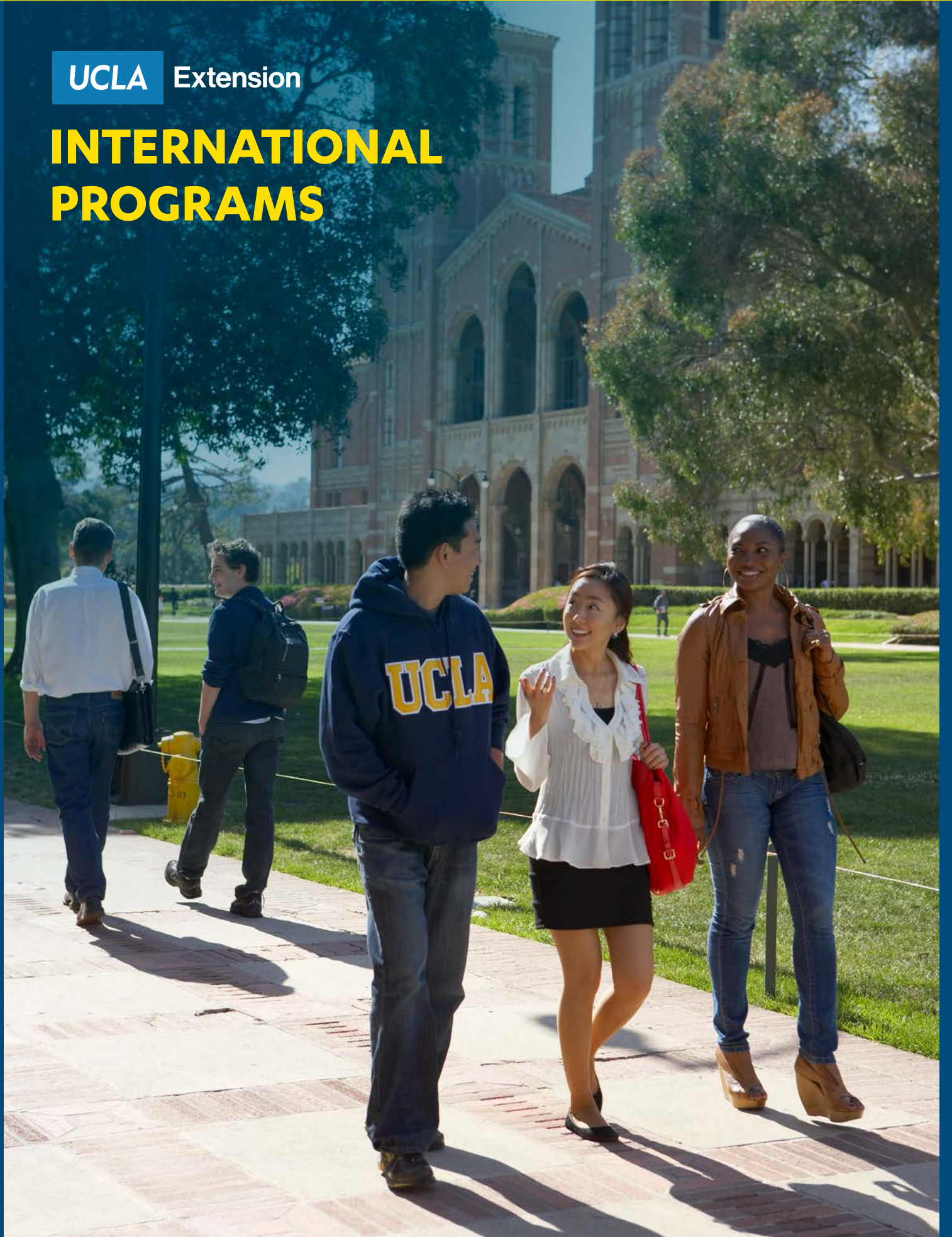

Certificate Programs for International Students

A certificate is a sequence of courses related to a specialized field or topic such as General Business Studies, Marketing, Entertainment Studies, Project Management, Digital Technology, Sustainability, and Journalism.

Certificate programs are not degree programs; however, many students who have bachelor's and master's degrees enroll in certificate programs to advance or change their careers.

UCLA Extension certificate programs are usually taught by working professionals who are experts in their fields; programs offer a practical, real-world approach to each field of study.

Program Overview

We offer over 40 F-1 visa-approved certificate programs that allow international students to study full-time in the U.S.

Exceptional Quality

Program Duration (mostly 6–12 months)

Longer programs offer a deeper understanding of each field.

Curricular Practical Training (CPT)

This internship directly relates to your certificate program. Offered as a course, the internship allows you to gain work experience in your field. To qualify for CPT, you must be enrolled in a program that offers the internship course, and you must complete nine months of full-time study in your program.

Optional Practical Training (OPT)

Get up to one year of paid work experience in the U.S. after you have successfully completed a certificate program lasting at least nine months.

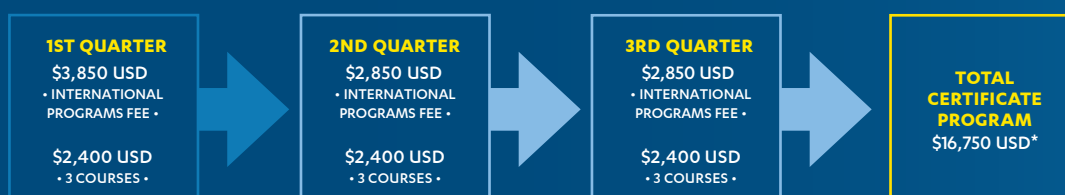

Program Overview

The Study Abroad at UCLA Program is designed for international students who want to earn transferable academic credits while living in and experiencing everything L.A. has to offer.

For Students Who Want To

- Earn academic credit you can transfer to a university.
- Enroll in UCLA undergraduate daytime and UCLA Extension evening courses.
- Study side by side with U.S. students, working professionals, and other international students.

In order to meet international student visa requirements, students must enroll in a minimum of 12 units of UCLA and/or UCLA Extension credit.

UCLA and UCLA Extension operate on the quarter system, with four 11-week sessions per year—fall, winter, spring, and summer. Study Abroad at UCLA offers UCLA Extension courses all four quarters and UCLA courses only in fall, winter, and spring. To enroll in summer UCLA courses, students can enroll in UCLA Summer Sessions by going to summer.ucla.edu. Students often stay for more than one quarter and it is easy to transfer between Study Abroad at UCLA and UCLA Summer Sessions.

Online: Course content is delivered weekly through an online learning platform where you can engage with your instructor and classmates at your convenience. Assignments are due regularly, but there are no required class meetings. Optional office hours with the instructor are offered through Zoom. This flexible learning format allows you to access course content anywhere, anytime, on your schedule.

Remote: All class meetings are scheduled and held in real-time using Zoom, allowing for live interaction with your classmates and instructors. Course materials can be accessed any time through an online learning platform.

Hybrid (Remote): A blend of remote and online instruction, this learning format features some scheduled, live class meetings using Zoom and some pre-recorded instruction, activities, discussion boards, or other course materials accessible through an online learning platform where you can connect with your instructor and classmates.

Program Overview

- UCLA on-campus housing is available only in the summer, for those enrolled in full-time American Language Center programs (AIEP, IECP) or Study Abroad.

Los Angeles and Campus Experience

Los Angeles

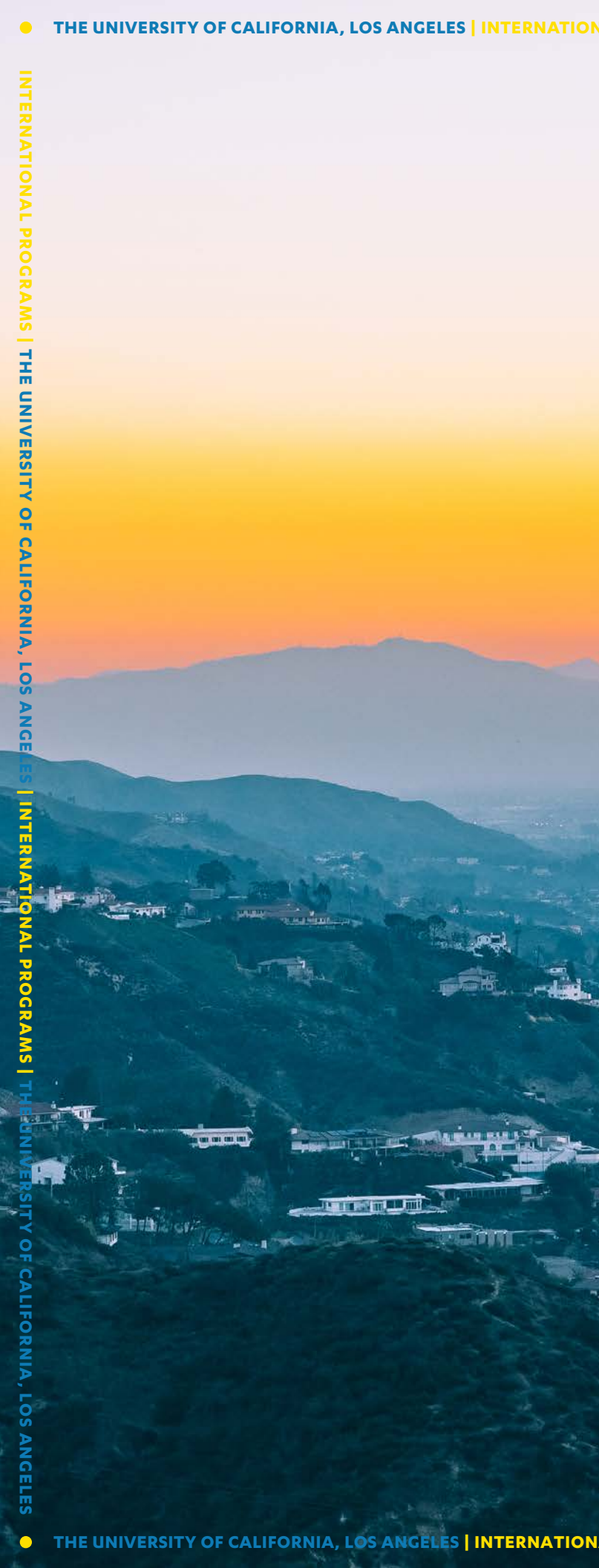
